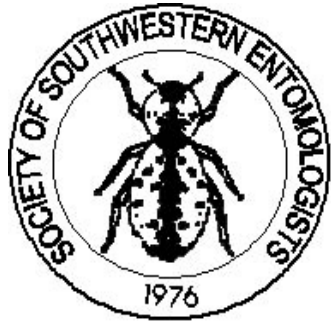

- Journal page charges are \$50.00 per page for members and \$55.00 per page for non-members.
- Guidelines for preparation of manuscripts are published in the September issue each year and are available from the Editor.
- Manuscripts may be submitted in either English or Spanish. Contact Julio Bernal for Spanish language manuscript.
- All manuscripts are subjected to peer review. Manuscripts involving all aspects of entomology will be considered.
- Full length research articles have an abstract, introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, and literature cited sections.
- A special section entitled "Perspective" is available for contributions of general interest with an emphasis on papers of a theoretical or historical nature.

- Scientific notes concerning important observations and new techniques are considered for publication.

- In addition to quarterly issues, full length supplements are occasionally published. Supplements treat specific topics in depth and may contain multiple manuscripts. Some examples are:
